STAR values and the Municipal Solid Waste Charging Scheme



Recently, the Municipal Solid Waste Charging Scheme has raised public awareness of environmental protection. It reminds us that our beloved city needs our immediate action on the management of municipal solid waste.

As an active member of our community, we have the responsibility to understand and proactively participate in finding sustainable solutions to alleviate such pressing problems.

Like many other urban regions, Hong Kong faces the challenge of waste generation. The amount of waste we produce on a daily basis is staggering that puts a strain on our landfills. To address this issue, the Hong Kong government has introduced the Municipal Solid Waste Charging Scheme. So, what exactly is such a scheme? Under this scheme, households and businesses are charged for the waste they generate, with the goal of incentivizing waste reduction and proper waste management practices. Back at the very beginning of my first school year, one of the teachers told us in a briefing: "Tsinghua is a place where you shatter and rebuild your confidence." What the teacher meant was that once you enrol in the university, it would be quick to find that a lot of people are really good at what they are doing, whether it is their studies or their hobbies. It would be

even easier to lose faith in your strengths and abilities when you compare yourself to them.

One might thus assume that competition between students is fierce and that might affect our relationship. In my experience, all my classmates are incredibly nice, and we get along well. They are very talented and studious individuals with broad interests and are more than willing to spend much of their time refining their projects and schoolwork to the best of their ability. More often than not, we find ourselves staying up late to work. Teachers frequently stress that we should learn from each other. In terms of my Urban Planning courses, this is especially apparent in our studio classes where we must work on design projects every semester. How did one design a particular area? How did they present their idea in terms of architectural plans? These are some of the questions we were expected to ask in order to improve our own designs. That being said, our lessons can be fun and unique. In the previous summer, we took a trip to Guizhou to learn surveying by measuring designated buildings in rural villages and recreating their floor plans and such on the computer. If I had not been given such precious opportunity, I wouldn't have had a chance to visit this rural village.

About Living in Beijing

Ever since pandemic measures have been lifted, I would go to nearby eateries for dinner with my friends. Hot pots are popular choices, as are barbeque restaurants, where we order raw meat and cook them ourselves on hot plates. To take a break from school work and exams, I would pay a visit to Jin Chun Yuan (近春园), an ex-royal-garden that's located right inside the school. There, I would take a stroll and admire the local fauna to ease myself from stress.

After living here for two years, I have realized that the best place to see ancient Chinese architecture the capital is known for is in the old districts, right at the heart of the modern metropolis. Since my school is in Haidian district, getting there means taking the metro to downtown. Once for a school project I walked through the city centre to take some photos. Even though I was expecting a lot of traditional buildings, I did not anticipate how many and how well kept they are, especially with the famous hutongs running between one-story houses. Only then did I feel like I grasped the definition of culture.

One of my fondest memories in the capital was the first time seeing real snow. Before this, I had never seen any with my own eyes, and I had always wondered what it felt like. My prayers were answered when my first winter in Beijing arrived. After a night of snowing, the ground was covered with the white substance, and after waking up I immediately got dressed and rushed outside to make a snow angel. Precious firsts remind me the very reason why I chose to study in Beijing.
