Rules & Regulations

1. No refund will be made if a student quits the ECA during the academic year.
2. Students should change into their PE uniform when they attend the sports ECA.
3. If the red or black rainstorm signal or typhoon signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, the ECA lessons on that day will be cancelled and parents will be notified on eClass.
4. For Sports Teams, if the red or black rainstorm signal or typhoon signal No. 3 or above is hoisted or the AQHI is 10+, the training session on that day will be cancelled and parents will be notified on eClass.

Leave Regulations

1. Students should learn to practice commitment when they sign up for an ECA class. Hence, a good attendance of 80% or above would be expected.
2. Students should follow the school's standard request for leave procedures (please refer to the Student Handbook P.22-23) when applying for leave, with a parent's letter and a medical certificate (for sick leave that lasts for two days or more) submitted to the ECA teacher advisor for verification.
3. Student absence during the school day would be taken as an absence for the ECA class.
4. If a student fails to follow the school's request for leave procedures, follow-up actions will be taken by the ECA Committee.
5. Students who are absent due to other school commitment, e.g. representing the school in competitions, will be marked as exempted.
